




IN HONOR OF A PRESIDENT

heodore Roosevelt's passion for conservation flourished **L** during his time in the Badlands. Experience the magic of this rugged landscape and live the strenuous life in the park year-round. The park is comprised of three separate areas of land. The North and South Units feature scenic drives, wildlife viewing, hiking, visitors' centers, ranger-led programs and much more. The undeveloped Elkhorn Ranch Unit preserves the site of Roosevelt's 'home ranch' in a remote area along the Little Missouri River.

Among his enterprises were a beef packing plant, a stagecoach line, a freighting company, refrigerated railway cars, cattle and sheep raising, land ownership, and a new town which he called Medora, in honor of his wife.
