TO-DOS & MUST SEES

Just a few highlights from 70,400 acres of rugged wilderness.

TRNP is broken up into three sections: the North Unit, the South Unit, and Elkhorn Ranch Unit, each connected by the Little Missouri River.



SOUTH UNIT SCENIC LOOP DRIVE

With construction complete, enjoy the full 36-mile drive past the most popular scenic overlooks, trailheads, and even some prairie dog towns.



ELKHORN RANCH UNIT

This preserved site is where Teddy Roosevelt's home ranch once stood. Only a cabin's foundation stones remain, bringing a solemn and peaceful atmosphere to this remote area of the park.



HOODOOS

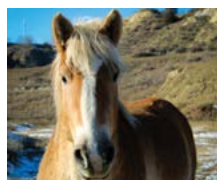
FROM THE STABLES TO THE STAGE

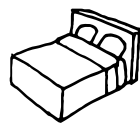

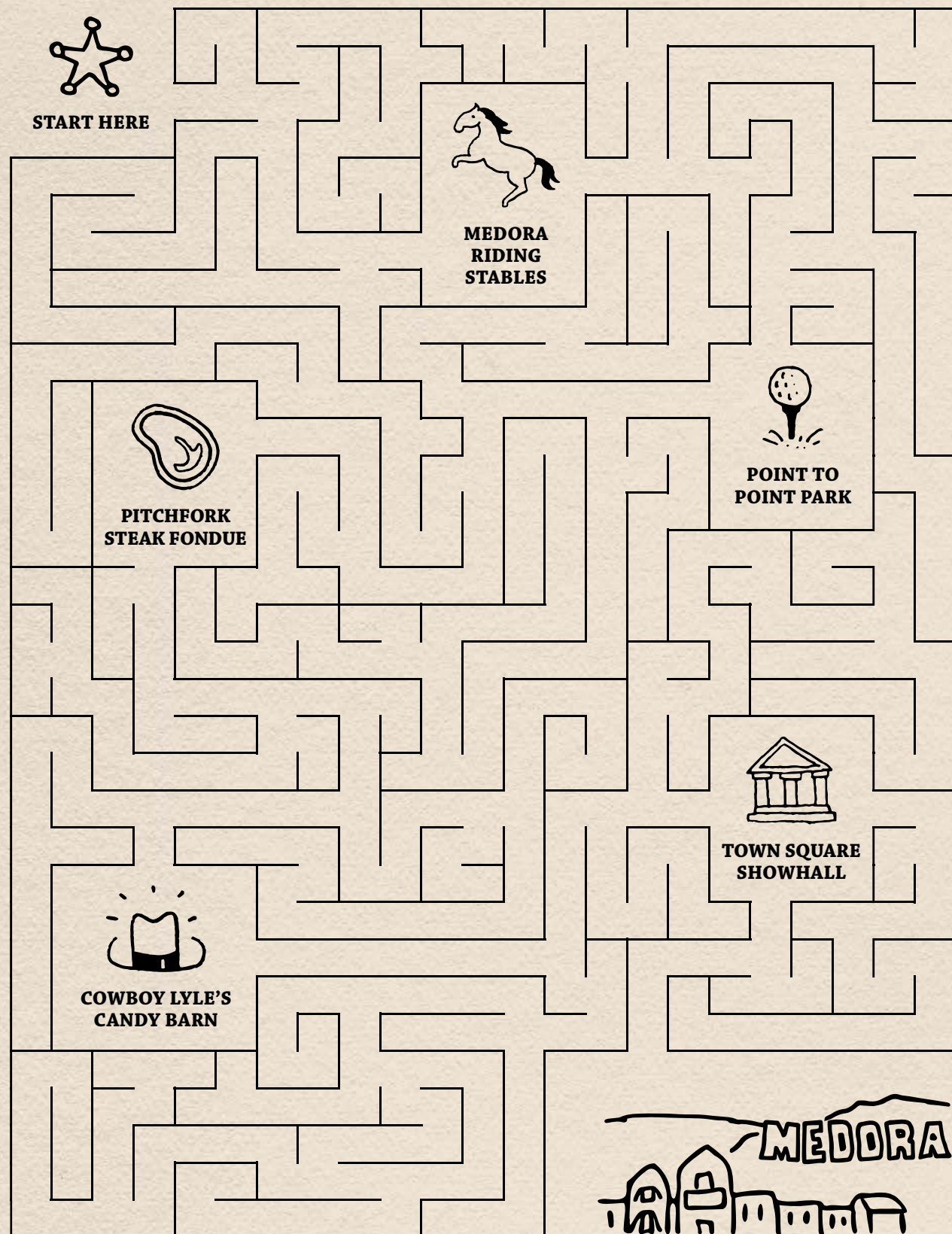
