

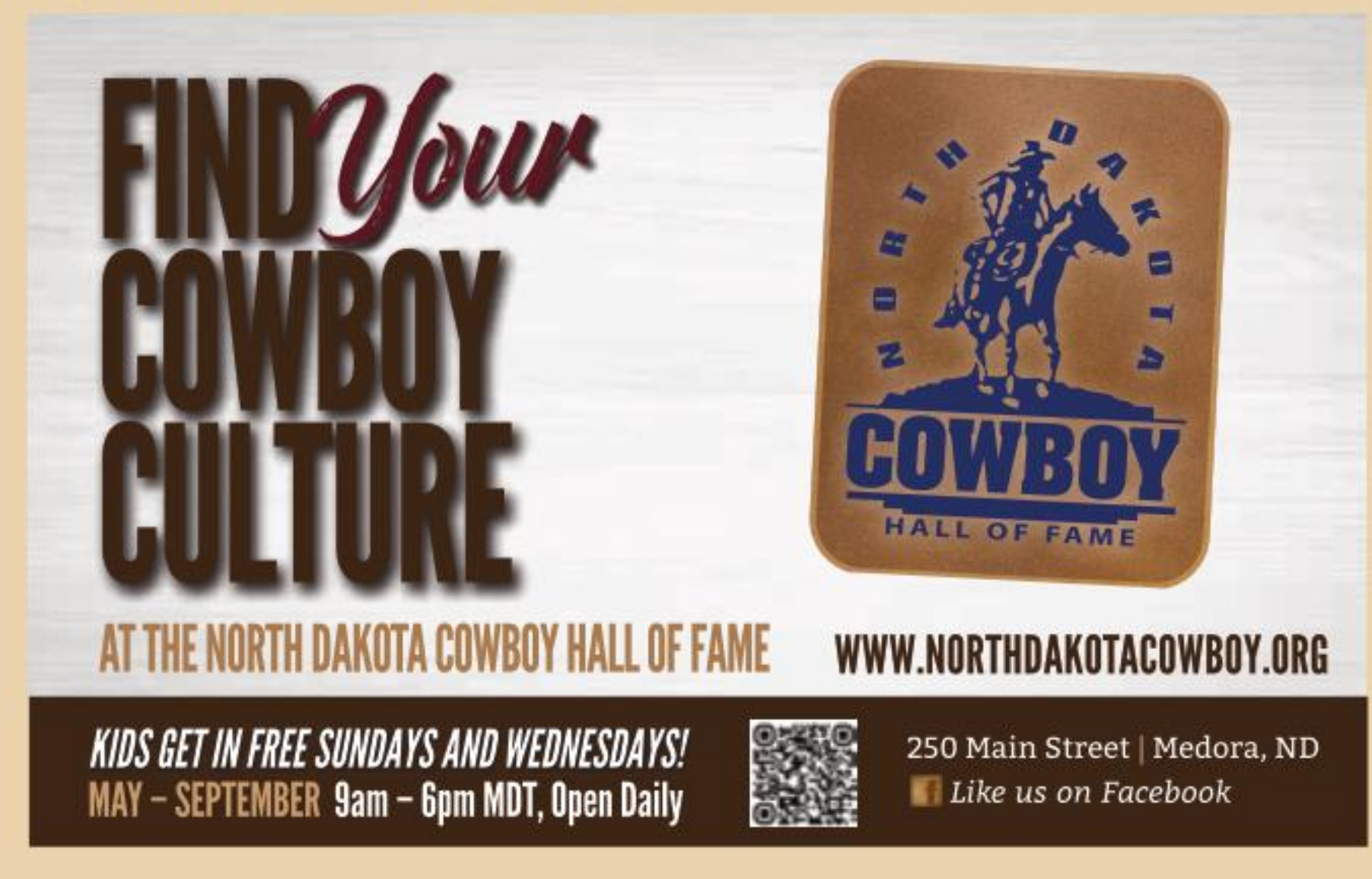

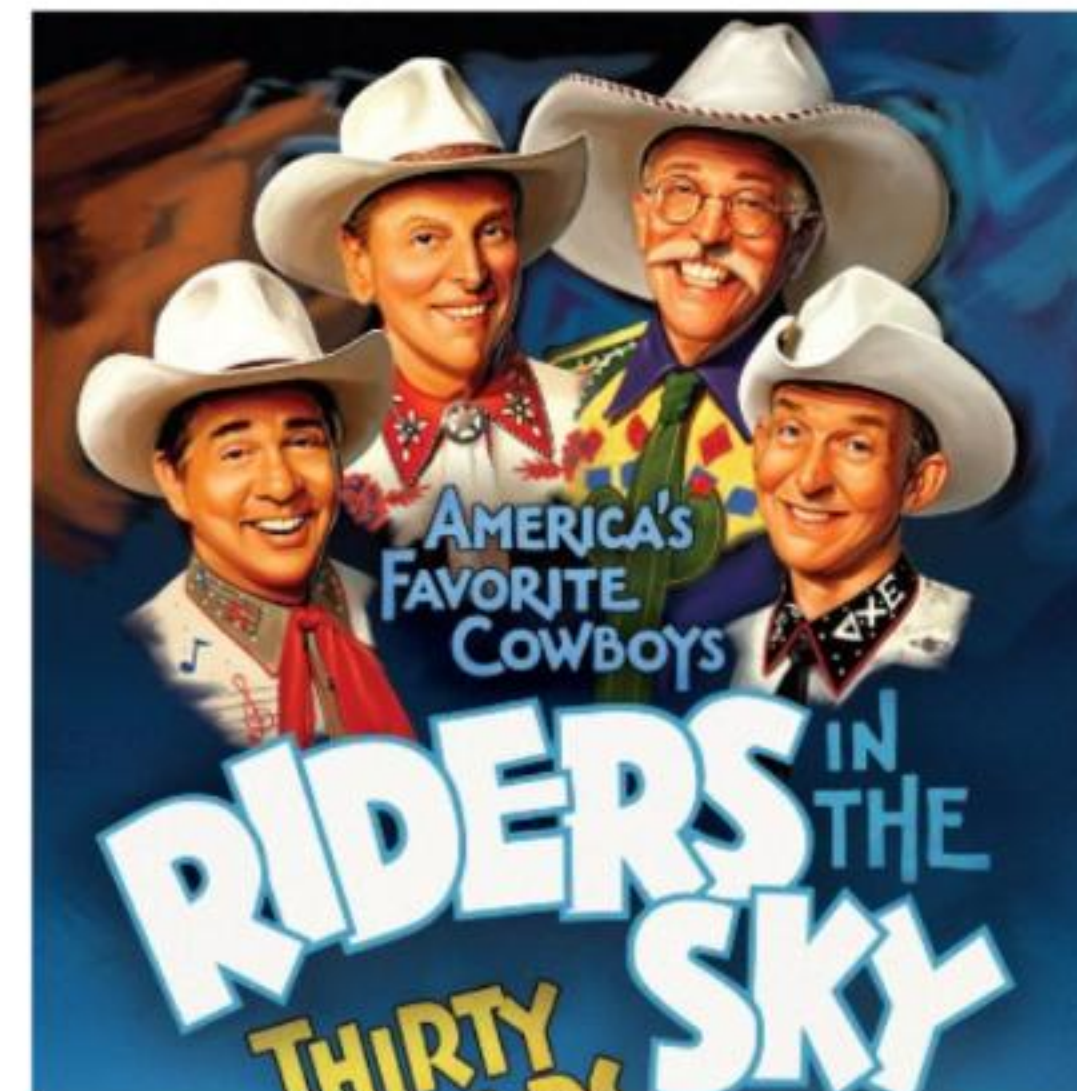
Chimney Park Stage
